It is expressly understood and agreed to as follows:

1. The space as stipulated in this contract is to be used solely for the business named during the exposition and cannot be transferred or any portion of it subject to another exhibitor or his/her agents.
2. Every exhibit must be setup and ready for inspection by 11 a.m. the first day of the show, September 10th, 2010.
3. Show sponsor shall furnish one table, two chairs, drapes and partitions for booth spaces and tables and chairs for lot spaces if requested.
4. Every exhibit shall be prepared in a neat and orderly style and must be kept clean by the exhibitor during the entire show. No flammable materials (such as crepe paper) shall be used in decoration of the exhibits as per fire code.
5. Sponsor reserves the right to control the use of the volume of any loudspeaker, radio, musical instrument or any noise making devices that might interfere with the exhibitors in the immediate area. Public address systems cannot be used except by special permission.
6. Sponsor will use all reasonable care to prevent loss or damage to exhibitor's property, but is not liable in any manner for such loss.
7. No inside exhibits shall be constructed in such away that it will interfere with the viewing of the exhibit next to it.
8. Exhibitors must furnish extension cords to connect to electricity.
9. Sponsor shall determine placement of exhibits and reserves the right to move any exhibitor. Exhibitors will be notified before being relocated.
10. The exhibitor agrees to hold show sponsor and all co-sponsoring organizations harmless.
11. CANCELLATION: If the exhibitor has paid fees in full and for some valid reason is not able to exhibit at herein mentioned show, the exhibitor will be refunded full space fees if he notifies the sponsor twenty-one (21) days prior to said show.
12. Payment in full is due upon registration. No booth shall be allowed to set up without prepayment.
13. The NFA shall not be held responsible for product shipped in nor shipped out of the Trade Show. All vendors are responsible for packaging, labeling, and to arrange for the shipping of their products immediately after the Trade Show to the next destination.
14. Early booth confirmation will be sent directly to you as soon as reasonably possible.
